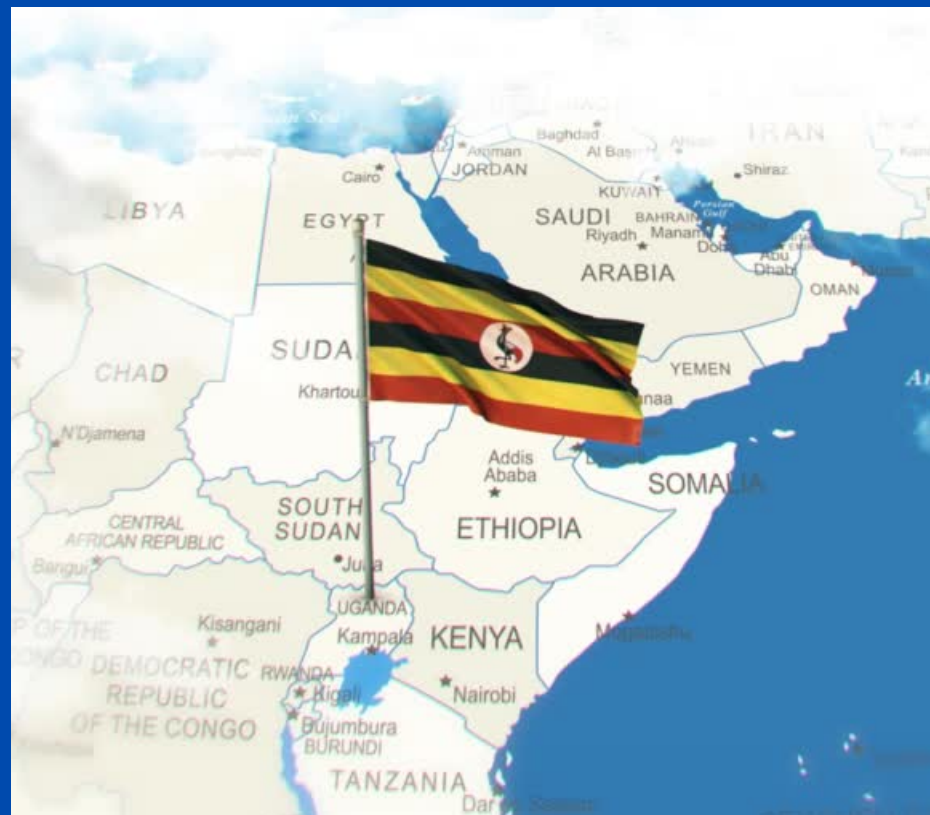

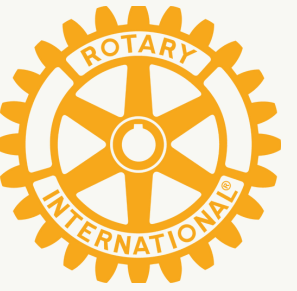

Uganda – Overview

- 25% of women in Uganda do not deliver in a medical facility
- Midwifery common (80%) - However over 70% lack formal education
- Birth 36 per 1,000 in the USA while only 12 per 1,000 in Uganda
- Infant mortality rate is sadly 33.3 per 1,000 in Uganda and 5.9 in the USA

Needs Assessment



Lukaya, Uganda

- Surrounding Town and Villages - approximate population of 150,000
- Clinic has only two old beds
- No doctor and only one nurse
- No accommodations for Midwives
- No available transportation
- Nearest hospital 40 minutes away
- Private sector beyond affordability \$400
- Pre and post-natal education is minimal



GLOBAL GRANT PROVISIONS

New Clinic: To become a Regional Center serving a population of 150,000 (about the size of Butler County)

Ambulance: For transportation and emergency response to hospital which is often 45 minutes away

Incinerator: To reduce waste and improve the environment

Public Toilet: Improved sanitary conditions around the clinic compound

Solar Power: This will insure consistent power supply to the clinic

Empowerment Programs: Piggery (pig farming) and Brick Making projects provide for local income and clinic stability



Education and Training: Ongoing pre/post natal care in community

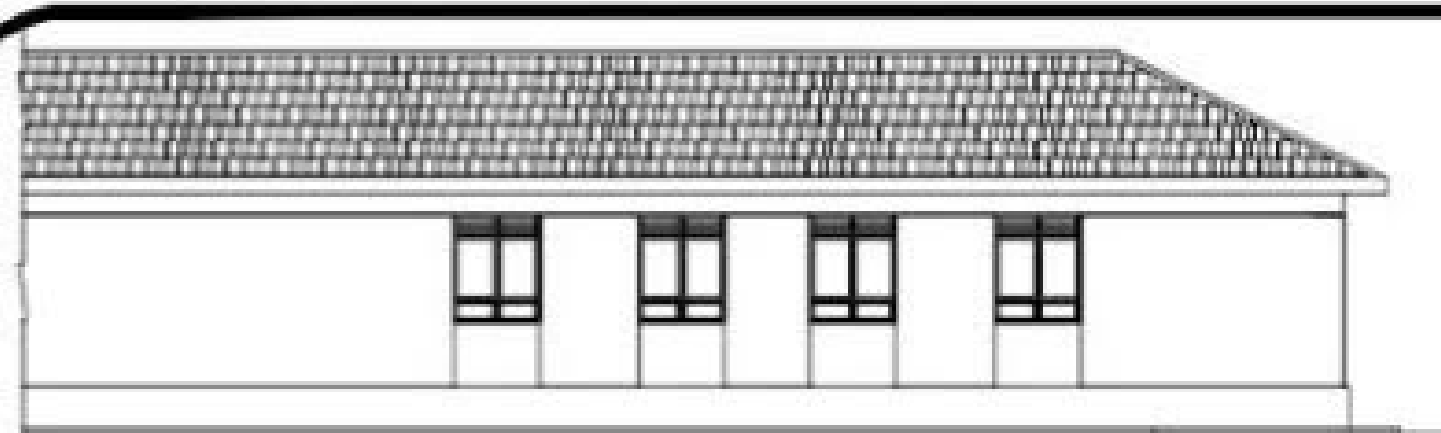

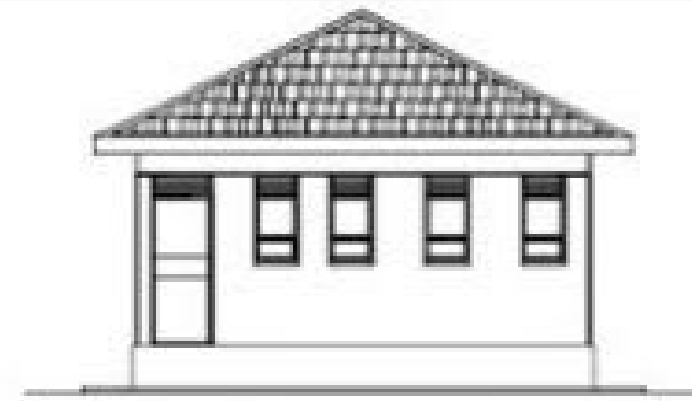


Current clinic in Lukaya



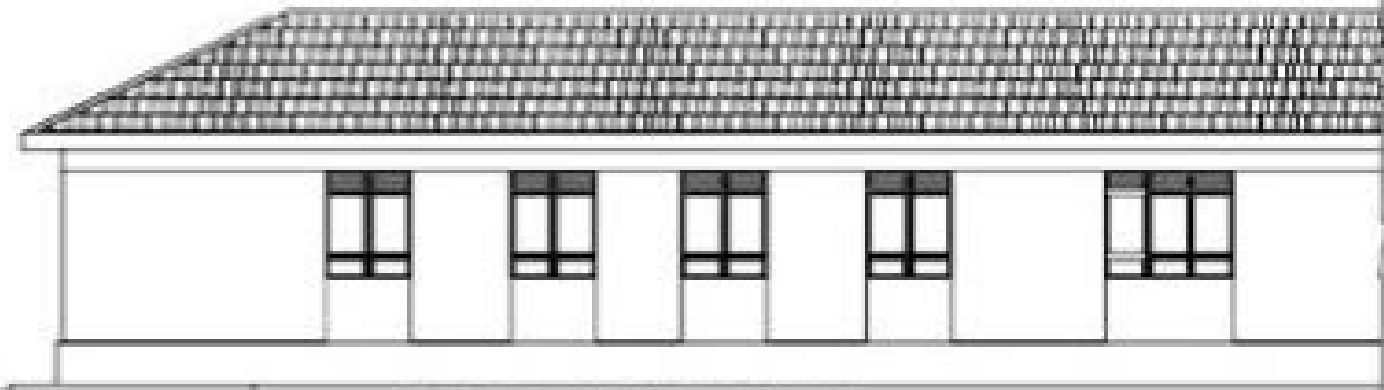
FRONT ELEVATION.

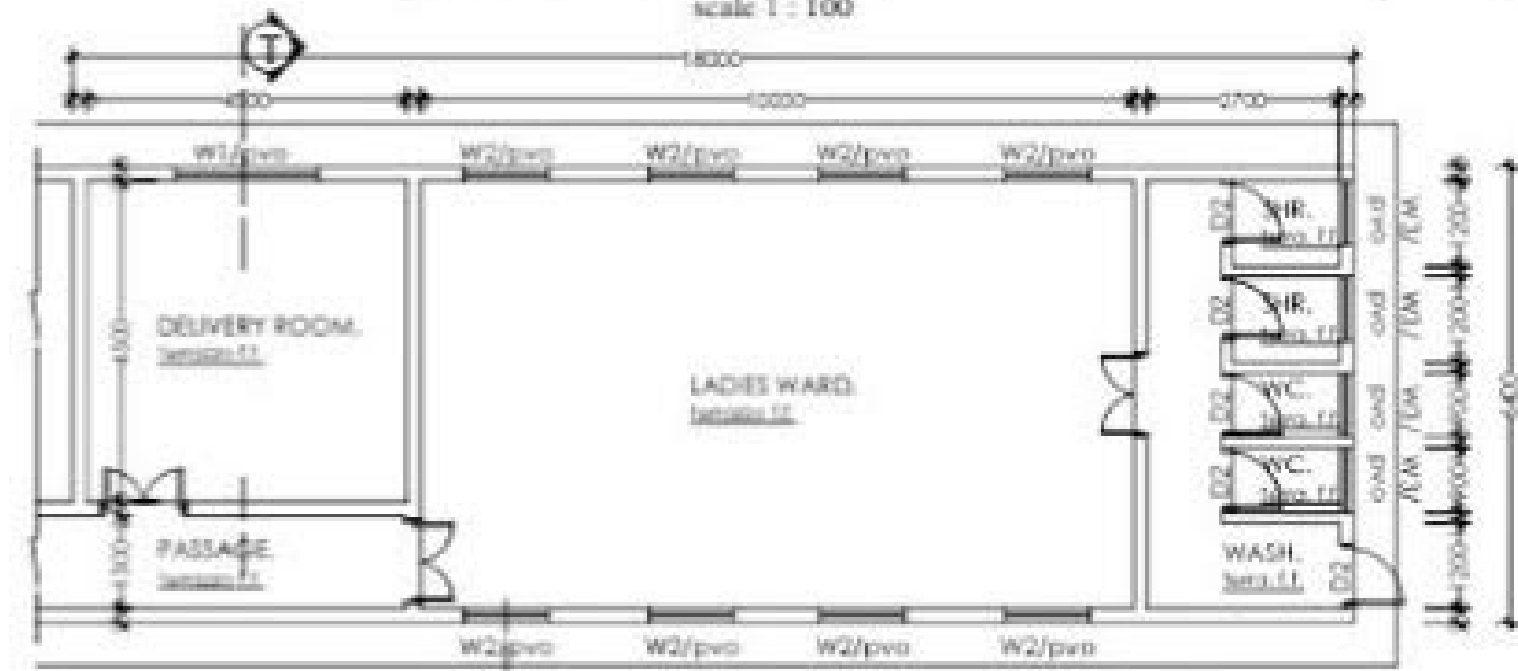
TOILETS ELEVATION.

CILING CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Use 12mm celotex ceiling boards fixed on 75x50mm battenings at 600mm c/c on 100x50mm joists at 600mm c/c on truss tie beams.

ROOF

Roof pitch 25 deg.
Mangalore tiles on 50x38mm timber battens on Polythene underlay on chicken wire mesh on 150x50mm principal rafters at 1800mm c/c 100x50mm common rafters at 600mm c/c on 100x50mm underpurlins at 1500mm c/c 100x50mm struts & ties on 150x50mm tie beams on 100x75mm wall plates, 230x25mm fascia & barge boards.



SECTION THRU T-T

scale 1 : 100

SUBSTRUCTURE

100mm high timber skirting
25mm cement screed of mix 1:3 on 150mm thick conc. floor slab of mix 1:3:4 on 230mm thick hardcore fillings on approved medium soil.
230mm thick plinth wall
Conc. foundation footing to structural engineer's detail
Depth of foundation trenches to be determined on site.

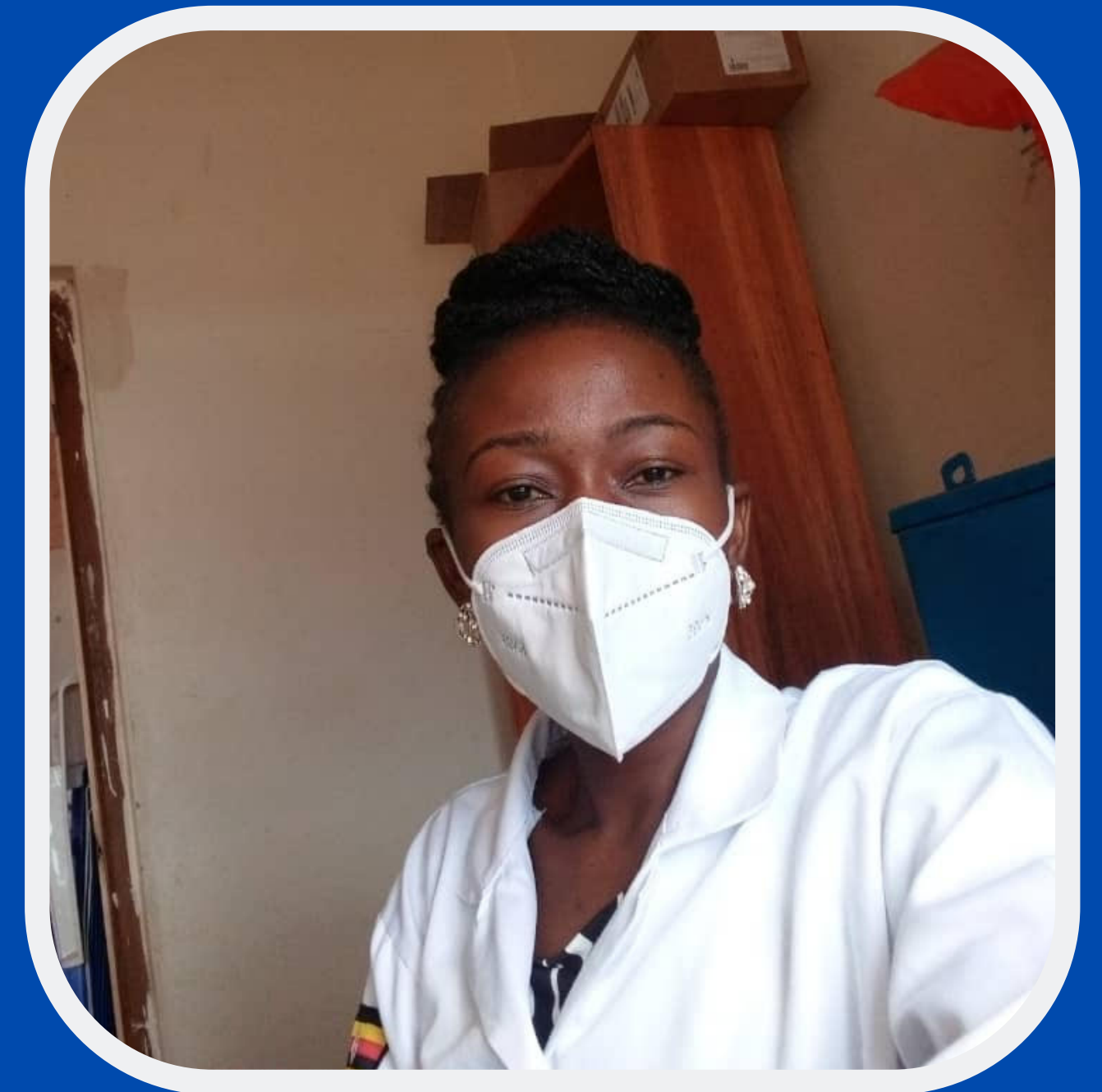

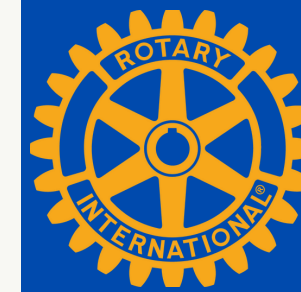

NEW way - only District Designated Funds (DDF) matched

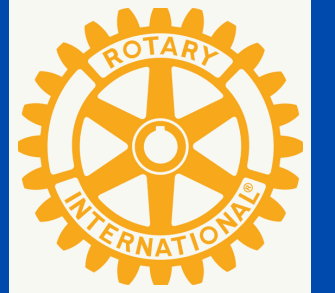
- Funding more difficult
